MAHESH GROVER, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing at length prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition. He states that he would surrender himself before the learned trial Court within a period of 10 days from today. He further makes a prayer that in the eventuality of his regular bail application being filed the same be decided expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the State contends that he has no objection to such course being adopted.

The petition stands disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court that if the petitioner surrenders and moves an application for regular bail within a period of 10 days from today

the same shall be granted consideration as expeditiously as possible but not later than one week from the date when such a prayer is made.
