The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.95 dated 24.05.2013, registered under Sections 363, 366 IPC (subsequently Sections 342, 376 120-B IPC were added and Section 366 IPC converted into Section 366-A IPC), Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that statement of the prosecutrix has been recorded and she has not supported the prosecution version. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that petitioner no.1 is in custody since 01.06.2013 whereas petitioner no.2 is in custody since 16.06.2013.

The State counsel has opposed the bail application but submits that out of 23 witnesses, 20 witnesses have been examined.

In view of the submissions made on behalf of the petitioners and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
