JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 49, dated 21.10.2014, under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Women Police Station, Bathinda, District Bathinda (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom, on the basis of compromise.

2. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise appears to be genuine, voluntarily and without any coercion or undue influence. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature,

which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 49, dated 21.10.2014, under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Women Police Station, Bathinda, District Bathinda and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua petitioners.
