Amandeep and Jaswant Rai, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No. 5 to 8 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents no. 5 to 8. They have placed on record photographs, Annexure P-3. The petitioners have submitted a representation dated 26.04.2015, Annexure P-4 to respondent no.2. When confronted with the address of the petitioners mentioned on representation Annexure P-4, learned counsel conceded that inadvertently wrong address has been mentioned therein and the petitioners are residing somewhere else. He submits that the petitioners would again file a representation before respondent No.2.

Without commenting upon the legality of the marriage and entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent no.2 to decide the representation to be filed by the petitioners within a period of one month from the date of filing of the same and grant the protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
