**HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)**

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Ved Pal son of Chandermuni in case bearing FIR No.153 dated 14.8.2014 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station, Nathusari Chopta, District Sirsa.

Vide order dated 30.4.2015, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to his joining of investigation and complying the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Om Parkash, states that pursuant to order dated 30.4.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 30.4.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
