ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No.49 dated 06.04.2010 registered under Sections 382/148/149 IPC, Police Station Lambi, District Muktsar Sahib and the consequent proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioners urges that the FIR is of 2010 and a compromise had been effected and a cancellation report had been prepared but it appears that it was not accepted and the petitioners are students and have to go abroad for higher studies. He urges that the complainant is also present in the Court and the matter can be disposed of.

The State counsel states that cancellation report had been prepared.

The counsel appearing for respondent no.2 states that complainant is present and his reply by way of affidavit is also being filed and the matter may be disposed of.

In view of the urgency explained, the statement of the complainant has been recorded. He states that the matter has been compromised.

No useful purpose would be served to keep the FIR pending.

In view of the statements and report of the trial Court and the principles laid down by the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, 2007(3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, approved by Hon'ble Apex Court in **Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others (2012) 10 SCC 303**, the instant petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR and all consequent proceedings conducted on the basis thereof are quashed.

Needless to say that parties shall remain bound by the terms of compromise and their statements made in the Court below.
