Prayer in this petition is for quashing of Complaint No.241/2/12 of 20.12.2012 titled "Amandeep Kaur versus Hardeep Singh and others" qua petitioners and summoning order dated 20.12.2012 passed by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners instead of arguing the case on merits, submits that considering the nature of the allegations made in the complaint, let the personal appearance of the petitioners be exempted during the trial.

As regards the relationship, petitioner No.1 is married sister

of the husband of the complainant (*Nanad*), petitioner No.2 is the husband of petitioner No.1. Similarly, petitioners No.3 and 4 are maternal uncles of the husband of the complainant and petitioner No.5 is the son of petitioner No.3.

Taking into consideration the relationship of the petitioners viz a viz the complainant, the personal appearance of the petitioners shall remain exempted during the trial.

The petitioners are at liberty to take all pleas available to them before the trial Court as admissible under the law.
