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MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner's vehicle is said to have been involved in heroin smuggling. The petitioner would plead false implication and innocence.

On due consideration of the matter, I am of the view that it is not a fit case where power under Section 438 Cr.P.C. should be exercised in favour of the petitioner. The plea of the petitioner of false implication per se cannot be accepted in the wake of the conceded involvement of his vehicle in smuggling the contraband. Such matters need a deeper probe and therefore enlarging the petitioner on pre-arrest bail is likely to obstruct such approach.

Petition dismissed.
