Notice of motion to the respondents.

2. On the asking of Court, Ms. Priyanka Sadar, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

3. Mr. Jasinder Singh Thind, Advocate has also put in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 4 and 5 and has filed memorandum of appearance, which is taken on record.

4. This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents

No. 4 and 5 as they have solemnized marriage against the wishes and

consent of respondents No.4 and 5.

5. At the request of learned counsel for respondents No. 4 and 5, a meeting of petitioner No. 1 was arranged with respondent No.5 in the Court itself and time was provided to them to have a talk with each other but with no fruitful result.

6. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioners is that prior to filing of instant petition seeking protection, petitioners also moved representation (Annexure P-5) to redress their grievances but no action has been taken by respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa.

7. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa to look into the grievances of the petitioners unfolded by them in their representation dated April 28, 2015 (Annexure P-5) and if found necessary, take appropriate measures in accordance with law.

8. However, this order shall not be construed as a measure to treat the marriage of the petitioners valid or legal.
