ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.06 dated 10.01.2015, registered under Section 15/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur.

A case was registered when the petitioner was found to be in possession of 5 bags of Poppy Husk containing 30 Kgs. each. The petitioner has approached this Court for bail at the stage when the investigations are going on and the challan has not been filed. The recovery effected from the petitioner is commercial.

The argument made on behalf of the petitioner is that petitioner was carrying the goods which had been loaded in the truck and it was the owners who should have been booked.

The State counsel informs that the owners were also called and case has been registered under Section 25 of the NDPS Act.

The petitioner is the driver of truck. Taar roles meant for Power Grid Corporation of India were loaded and dispatched for Rajpura, Patiala. The petitioner claims that on the way on 07.01.2015 old newspapers weighing 6215 Kgs. were loaded and he was not concerned with the articles loaded in the truck except to count the bundles and was not involved.

The petitioner has been found to be in possession of intoxicating drugs which are commercial in nature. The investigations are going on. No case for bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
