By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.17, dated 17.02.2014, registered under Sections 420/467/468/120-B IPC, at Police Station Sadar, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 21.09.2015/04.05.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order dated 21.09.2015/04.05.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 21.09.2015/04.05.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
