This the the third petition filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.216, dated 24.11.2011, under Sections 302/34/427/323 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (in short 'the Cr.P.C.'), registered at Police Station Patti, District Taran Taran.

Report of Superintendent, Central Jail, Gurdaspur has been received to the effect that the petitioner has been shifted to Central Jail, Amritsar.

Report of Addl. Sessions Judge, Tarn Taran, has also been received.

Affidavit of Manmohan Singh, ASI, Incharge Police Post Toot, Police Station, Patti, District Tarn Taran filed, wherein it is stated that now the prosecution evidence is complete and the statement of accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C. has also been recorded and the case is now fixed for defence evidence for 22.07.2015. Therefore, it is clear that the trial is going to be conclude very soon.

In view of these circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, it is requested that the trial may be disposed of expeditiously.

In view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed for the time being.

However, the trial court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously. It is also made clear that no unnecessary adjournment shall be granted to either party.
