REKHA MITTAL, J.(ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press his prayer for setting aside order dated 15.11.2014 in the present proceedings without prejudice to his rights to challenge that order by way of separate proceedings.

It is further submitted that the petitioner has been summoned to face trial in a private complaint filed by respondent No.2 and was allowed benefit of pre-arrest bail by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana but since he failed to surrender his passport in compliance with the directions issued by the Court, his application for bail in anticipation of arrest was eventually dismissed on 09.12.2014. The petitioner is ready to surrender his passport before the trial Court in compliance with the directions issued by the Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, subject, however, without prejudice to his rights to challenge the said condition in the bail order in appropriate proceedings. It is further submitted that the

petitioner is ready to face proceedings, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Hemender Goswami, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

The petitioner is directed to put in appearance before the trial Court within 10 days, surrender his passport and on his appearance, he shall be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of said Court. In case the petitioner fails to surrender before the trial Court and also submit his passport in original along with an affidavit that he is not holder of any other passport except the one submitted in the Court, the petition shall be deemed to be dismissed.

Disposed of accordingly.
