Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that during the pendency of the appeal before learned Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur, the better sense has prevailed and both the parties have resolved their dispute and effected a compromise. It has also been pointed out that statements of the parties have also been recorded by the learned trial Court and copies thereof have been sent to this Court.

During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition to enable the petitioners to take the advantage of the compromise so effected before the learned Appellate Court in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the State as well as learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 4 has no objection to the above prayer.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with a direction to learned Appellate Court (Learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur) where the appeal filed by the petitioners is pending for adjudication, to consider the factum of compromise while deciding the appeal on merits, in accordance with law.
