Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. at the initial stage itself by granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No. 4 i.e. Inspector General of Police, NRI Cell, Phase-VII, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali as regards his grievance of being harassed at the behest of respondent No. 10 in connivance with respondent No. 6.

Such liberty is being granted to the petitioner without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without going into the merit of the case.

It is, however, observed that in case the petitioner approaches respondent No. 4 with regard to his grievance, the same be looked into and thereafter steps be taken by respondent No. 4 as he may deem fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.
