Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.118 dated 21.12.2014 under Section 61/1/14 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Rampura, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 30.4.2015, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to his joining of investigation and complying the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rajwinder Singh, states that pursuant to order dated 30.4.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation and the recovery already stands effected from him.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 30.4.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
