This order will dispose of two petitions,
CRM-M-13887-2015 filed by Sukhraj Singh etc. for quashing of
FIR No.67, dated 27.10.2014, under Sections
354-B/324/323/341/506/148/149 IPC and 25, 27 of Arms Act,
registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur and

CRM-M-14259-2015 filed by Parveen Kumari etc. for quashing of cross-version recorded vide rapat No.24, dated 28.10.2014 in the aforesaid FIR. It has been averred that matter has been compromised in the main case as well as in cross-version case.

Parties were directed to appear before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Gurdaspur to get their statements recorded. After recording the statements of the parties separately, the Illaqa Magistrate has sent a report that the matter has been voluntarily compromised without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the said circumstances, the aforesaid FIR and cross-version and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed following the Full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh & Ors. Vs. State of Punjab & Ors., 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal), 1052,** on the basis of compromise, subject to the condition that petitioners in the above said both petitions, will deposit a total sum of ₹ 10,000/- each, with Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Sector-22, Chandigarh, within a period of one month.
