Counsel submits that petitioner no.1 Kamaljeet Kaur was earlier married to one Harjinder Singh and out of wedlock two children were born and who are minors as of date. It has further been averred that Harjinder Singh, who is working in Kuwait, deserted petitioner no.1 two years back and has performed another marriage. Under such circumstances, Kamaljeet Kaur was thrown out of her matrimonial home by her in-laws. It is contended that parents of Kamaljeet Kaur are forcing and pressurizing her to now enter into matrimony with an elderly person and which has forced her to run away from her parental home and she is now living with petitioner no.2 namely Rinku Singh.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking directions to the official respondents for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners as they apprehend threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.4 to 6, who are parents and close relatives of Kamaljeet Kaur.

Without making any comments and observations on such live-in relationship between the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of in terms of granting liberty to the petitioners to approach respondent no.2

confined as regards the apprehension and threat that they face to their life and liberty and who in turn would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
