FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 16.05.2015 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st

Class, Dasuya has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Mohd. Yaqub and Paramjit Singh @ Pamma and the accused persons namely Massum Hussan @ Massum Ali, Jumait Ali and Siphayia, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, the submissions made that the parties are correlated and there was a dispute over the vehicle coupled with the fact that the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature and that compromise will go a long way in resolving the personal dispute and in bringing about peace, amity and harmony in the families who are correlated and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.16 dated 13.04.2015 registered at Police Station Gardhiwal, District Hoshiarpur under Sections 365, 395 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
