Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.154 dated 28.10.2011 under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 1.5.2015 of this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and the trial Court has admitted him on anticipatory bail on his furnishing of bail bonds/surety bonds, as required by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid factual position and submits that further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 1.5.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
