The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail for a period of two weeks on account of marriage of daughter of petitioner.

Petitioner is undergoing incarceration for having violated the provisions of Section 15 of NDPS Act leading to FIR No.127 dated 27.09.2012 registered under Section 15 of NDPS Act at Police Station Bagha Purana, District Moga. He was found in possession of 10 bags of poppy husk.

On 30.04.2015, notice of motion was issued and the factum of marriage has not been disputed.

As per custody certificate filed by State counsel, the petitioner is in custody for the last 2 years, 06 months and 28 days and no other offence of the like nature is registered against him.

Be that as it may, the limited prayer made in this petition for grant of interim bail for performing the marriage of daughter of the petitioner, is accepted considering the circumstances and the petitioner

is directed to be enlarged on interim bail w.e.f. 02.05.2015 till 09.05.2015 on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial court, Moga. The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authority or the court as ordered on 10.05.2015.

The present petition stands disposed of.
