Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.742 dated 27.12.2014, registered at Police Station Central Faridabad, under Section 20 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that charge has been framed. The recovery of ganja weighing 3 kgs 850 grams allegedly effected from the petitioner falls within the category of non-commercial quantity.

The petitioner has been behind bars since 27.12.2014.

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Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Faridabad.
