ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.247 dated 31.08.2013, registered under Sections 306, 506 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonapat.

Heard.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was married to the deceased in January, 2013. She had committed suicide when she was in her parents house on 30.08.2013. It was urged that facts came into light that the deceased was earlier married to the complainant and it is the first husband who has got the FIR registered. It was urged that the petitioner has earlier approached this Court for

protection but had withdrawn the petition and liberty was granted to file fresh bail petition after the examination of material witnesses. He urges that out of 18 PWs, 16 witnesses have been examined and the petitioner is in custody since September, 2013.

The main witnesses have been examined. The trial is taking time. There are disputed facts. Co-accused Ravinder was admitted to bail by Additional Sessions Judge. Without commenting upon the merits of this case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
