This petition has been moved by Karam Singh under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.95 dated 28.5.2014 registered under Sections 15/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib.

The petitioner is in custody for the last one year, i.e. since 28.5.2014. He was allegedly found in possession of 60 kilograms of poppy husk out of which 5 kilogram was recovered at the spot while remaining quantity was recovered later as a result of disclosure statement made by him.

As per the custody certificate filed today, another case under the NDPS Act stood registered against the petitioner before the present one. It is submitted by counsel for the petitioner that in the other case, the quantity was non-commercial and the petitioner is on bail.

Trial has not yet begun. Evidence has not started. The trial will, therefore, take long time to conclude.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
