The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. praying for the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.48 dated 06.02.2015, under Sections 323/328/376/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, Ambala Cantt.

Allegations against the petitioner are very serious in nature. The prosecutrix is stated to have been enticed to the house of the present petitioner by his wife, who was stated to be the colleague of the prosecutrix and thereafter having committed the offence of rape. Even photographs are stated to have been clicked by the wife of the petitioner. Further allegations are with regard to having extorted money and jewelry from the prosecutrix under threat of making the pictures public.

In the light of the gravity of the alleged offence, this Court does not find any infirmity in the order dated 23.04.2015 passed by the learned

Additional Sessions Judge, Ambala declining the prayer for concession of

bail to the petitioner.
