This is a petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Sukhdev Singh, seeking pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case bearing FIR No. 55, dated 06.07.2014, under Sections 325, 323 IPC, registered at Police Dera Baba Nanak, District Batala.

2. While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on May 06, 2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter-alia* contends that marriage of complainant with petitioner was solemnized about 8-9 years ago and two children were born out of the said wedlock. Moreover, the role attributed

to her father-in-law, mother-in-law and brother-in-law is that they pushed her in stair case, as a result of which she sustained injuries. He further contended that initially FIR was registered under Sections 325 and 323 IPC and offence under Section 498-A IPC has been added later on just to harass the petitioner and his family. Even though it came to light that real dispute between the parties is on some petty matters and not with regard to demand of dowry.

Notice of motion for 20.07.2015.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest petitioner shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. He shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer. He shall also comply with the other conditions as envisaged under

Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions has submitted that

in compliance of order dated May 06, 2015, petitioner has already joined the investigation on May 16, 2015 and is also no more required for further investigation in this case.

Taking into consideration all the aforesaid aspects of the case, order dated May 06, 2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions, as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
