Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered against her on the allegations that she along with her co-accused had taken a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- from the complainant for sending him to Canada. The petitioner is female and she claims to be partner with her co-accused, running M/s Skyway Immigration Consultants at Ludhiana. She was involved in another case of the similar nature in which she was granted the concession of bail on 10.07.2015.

On the instructions of ASI Rumel Singh, it has been informed that challan has been presented and charges stand framed. Two other co-accused are in custody.

The petitioner can be granted concession of bail in view of the proviso of section 437(1) Cr.P.C being a female.

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Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that she will not leave India without prior permission of the Court and will not commit any similar offence of which she is accused of during pendency of the trial. In case of any such eventuality, this bail order will be liable to be cancelled on an application filed by the prosecution agency.
