This order shall dispose of aforesaid two petitions i.e
CRM No. M-14077 of 2015, filed by Harmesh Chand and others and
CRM No. M-14018 of 2015, filed by Harmesh Singh and others.

2. CRM No. M-14077 of 2015, has been filed under Section

482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.102 dated 06.10.2008, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 34 IPC and Sections 201, 148, 149, 341, 325 IPC added later on and Section 452 and 34 IPC deleted later on, registered at Police Station Banur, District Patiala (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 18.04.2015 (Annexure P-2).

3. CRM No.M-14018 of 2015 has also been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing cross DDR No.30, dated 06.10.2008 arising in FIR No. 102, dated 06.10.2008, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 34 IPC and Section 201 added later on and Section 452 deleted later on, registered at Police Station Banur, District Patiala and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom, on the basis of compromise dated 18.04.2015.

4. Report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have compromised the matter voluntarily without any undue pressure and coercion. No other case is pending between the parties. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

5. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

6. Consequently, both these petitions stand allowed and

FIR No.102 dated 06.10.2008, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 34 IPC and Sections 201, 148, 149, 341, 325 IPC added later on and Section 452 and 34 IPC deleted later on, registered at Police Station Banur, District Patiala as also cross DDR No.30, dated 06.10.2008 in FIR No. 102, dated 06.10.2008, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 34 IPC and Section 201 added later on and Section 452 deleted later on, registered at Police Station Banur, District Patiala and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed qua petitioners.
