The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for issuance of directions to the official respondents to take adequate measures to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners on the basis of an apprehension that has been voiced in the petition as regards threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.2 to 8.

Without even going into the correctness of the assertions and averments made in the petition and without making any observations on merit, the present petition is disposed of at the very initial stage with liberty to the petitioner to approach Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar with regard to her apprehension and grievance and who in turn would be obligated to look into the matter and thereafter to take steps, if necessary and deemed fit and as warranted strictly in accordance with law.
