FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.397 dated 09.09.2014 under Sections 306, 34 IPC Act registered at Police Station, Rohtak City.

The allegations against the petitioners are that the petitioner No.1 Harish is maternal aunt's son of Seema widow of the deceased and petitioner No.2 Raju @ Raj Kumar is paternal uncle's son and it is submitted that similarly placed co-accused Seema has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 7.4.2015. It is squarely accepted on behalf of the State that there is no specific role attributed to these petitioners in commission of an offence.

In view thereof and keeping in view the principle of parity and without adverting onto the merits of the case the present petition is allowed. Accordingly, both the petitioners are

ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Rohtak.
