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MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for release of the petitioner on bail in terms thereof in a case registered vide FIR No.4 dated 19.1.2015 under Sections 406/498-A/420 IPC at Police Station Women Cell Patiala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the dispute had arisen essentially on account of a marital discord.

Noticing this, the Court had granted the interim protection to the petitioner on 4.5.2015, pursuant to which he has since joined the investigation which fact is not controverted by the learned counsel appearing for the State.

Consequently, the interim directions dated 4.5.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
