This petition is for seeking protection of life and liberty of petitioners, who alleged to have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 and 5, father and brother of petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has limited his prayer for taking appropriate action in accordance with law on the representation dated 29.04.2015 (Annexure P-5) made by petitioner No.1. It has been stated that both the petitioners are major. The date of birth of petitioner No.1-Kamal Sharma is 29.08.1993 as per copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) and that of petitioner No.2-Lakhwinder Singh is 06.03.1986 as per copy of Fifth Standard Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2). They got married on 29.04.2015. Photographs of marriage are Annexure P-3.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the validity of

marriage of petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the representation dated 29.04.2015 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate action in accordance with law, on receipt of certified copy of this order and copy of representation (Annexure P-5) in his office.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect on the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
