Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.202 dated 22.9.2014 under Section 306/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana.

This Court vide order dated 11.5.2015 had granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to his joining investigation and complying the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 11.5.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Amrik Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial

interrogation of the petitioner is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the instant petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 11.5.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
