This is second bail petition.

As per allegations of the prosecution, petitioner gave sua blow which hit on the right eye near the eye brow.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the matter has been compromised and quashing petition on the basis of compromise has also been filed which is pending.

In my view, compromise is not a ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. A person who has given greivous injury on the eye brow, is not entitled for grant of bail.

No new ground for grant of anticipatory bail has arisen.
