The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 291, dated 21.10.2014, under Sections 260, 379, 411, 413, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been heard.

The FIR was registered on the basis of a secret information and as per which, Jasbir Kumar alias Bittu and Pawan Kumar alias Pannu had allegedly formed a gang to purchase stolen vehicles and thereafter selling such vehicles on the basis of forged and fabricated documents.

Even though name of the present petitioner did not figure in the FIR but it so transpires that during the course of investigation, his name has surfaced in the capacity of an official/clerk of the office of District Transport Office, Ferozepur as regards forging and fabricating the registration documents.

The allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature. To unearth the real truth, custodial interrogation of the petitioner may be warranted. This Court does not find any infirmity in the order dated 18.03.2015 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozepur declining the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Petition is dismissed.
