This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No. 215 dated 26.11.2014 under section 15 of N.D.P.S Act registered at Police Station, Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 15.1.2015:-

“Petitioner allegedly left a bag containing 27 kgs of poppy husk and escaped on seeing the police party.

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Punjab for 23.3.2015.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will join investigation on 31.1.2015. In case of petitioner doing so, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from H.C. Sukhdev Singh would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined the investigation. State counsel further makes a statement that no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not

required.

In view of such stand taken on behalf of the State, petition is allowed. Order dated 15.1.2015, passed by this Court is made absolute.

Petition disposed of.
