The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 136 dated 04.03.2015 registered at Police Station Rattia, District Fatehabad under Section 61/1/14 of the Excise Act and Section 420/201/120-B IPC.

The allegations are that a truck was loaded with liquor which was being transferred but in the records the consignment was shown as cattle feed. The driver failed to produce the bills. The police arrested the driver as well as owner who had sent the consignment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that investigation is over and challan has been submitted. The petitioner is in custody since 06.03.2015 and the magisterial trial will take long time to conclude.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the fact that trial will take long time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
