The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. raising a two fold prayer. In the first instance, directions are sought to the official respondents to take adequate steps for protection of the life and liberty of the petitioners on the basis of an apprehension that has been voiced against private respondent Nos. 4 to 6. The second prayer is for conduct of fair and impartial investigation pertaining to FIR No. 136 dated 30.12.2014, under Sections 379, 382, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length and without even going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the present petition at the initial stage itself in terms of directing respondent No. 2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar City to look into the matter in the light of a representation dated 24.04.2015 (Annexure P-4) i.e. stated to have already been submitted and thereafter to take steps as deemed fit and warranted strictly in accordance with law.

Petition disposed of.
