MAHESH GROVER, J.

The material on record indicates that the petitioner is involved in the offence of the like nature. All these FIRs were subsequently quashed on the basis of settlement. This indicates that the petitioner is habituated to the crime of the nature reflected in the FIRs. There would be thus no reason to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail which is intended to protect people from false implication. The petitioner is duping people at large. No ground to grant the concession of pre-arrest bail. The petition is dismissed.

The police is directed to carry out the arrest of the petitioner forthwith.
