As per averments in reply, petitioner no.2 was less than 21 years of age at the time of marriage and this marriage was in violation of provisions of Prohibition of Child Marriage Act, 2006 (for short 'the Act of 2006').

Learned State counsel submits that marriage had taken place at Panchkula as per certificate of marriage Annexure P-3 as such action for violation of provisions of the Act of 2006 is to be taken by the police at Panchkula only.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Copy of the order dated 1.5.2015 along with copy of this order be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Panchkula to take further action in accordance with law.
