Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 144, dated 21.03.2015, under Sections 323, 452, 506 & 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Mahendergarh.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that compromise has been entered into between the parties. Photocopy of compromise in

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vernacular has been filed in Court today which is taken on record.

Vide order dated 04.05.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioners would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioners have joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioners and their custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 04.05.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
