Prayer in this petition filed by petitioners Surinder Kaur wife of Joginder and Kulwant Kaur wife of late Gurjinder Pal Singh is for issuance of direction to the police not to conduct third enquiry as marked by SSP, Hoshiarpur to SP (D), Hoshiarpur and to proceed in accordance with law on the basis of enquiry report dated 18.1.2014.

Learned counsel for the State had filed reply dated 28.4.2015 by way of affidavit of Satish Kumar Sharma, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, City Hoshiarpur on behalf of respondents No.1, 2, 4, 6 and 7. Learned counsel for the respondent-State had also filed enquiry report dated

17.6.2014 of SP (D), Hoshiarpur as Annexure R-3.

When confronted with this report, learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that the petitioners would be satisfied if the respondents are directed to proceed on the said report in accordance with law.

Since the respondent-State has filed report and further proceedings are to be initiated after obtaining legal opinion from the District Attorney, Hoshiarpur, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent-State to act on the said report in accordance with law.
