The present petition has been filed by petitioner Bodh Raj @ Bodha for grant of anticipatory bail. He was arrested in the cross version case FIR No. 32 dated 23.3.2014, under Sections 323, 324, 452, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and was admitted to bail. But, later on the offence punishable under Section 326 Indian Penal Code, 1860 was added. His application for grant of anticipatory bail was dismissed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Pathankot. Hence this petition before this Court.

The petitioner was admitted to the interim anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 23.1.2015. Learned State counsel on the

instructions of Head Constable Surinder Singh, Police Station Sujanpur, Pathankot has stated that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and is no longer required for any custodial interrogation.

The grievous injury attributed to the applicant is the fracture on the little finger of the right hand which is not on the vital part of the body. The petitioner has already joined the investigation and is no longer required for any custodial interrogation.

Thus, the order of interim anticipatory bail dated 23.1.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.
