The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.81 dated 17.07.2014, registered under Sections 394, 413 IPC, Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that co-accused Sukhbir Singh @ Sukha was allowed bail who had several cases pending against him and there is no other case pending against the petitioner. He further states that petitioner is in custody since 16.08.2014 and the trial is not proceeding. He further states that complainant has been examined and there is no other eye witness.

Learned State counsel does not dispute that complainant has been examined and there is no other other case pending against the petitioner.

The complainant has been examined. There is no other eye-witness. The trial will take long time to conclude. Without

commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
