Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 307/452/34 and 25/54/59 of Arms Act in a case arising out of FIR No.27 dated 27.02.2010, registered at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar.

As per the allegations in the FIR, the complainant-Manjit Singh was attacked in his courtyard by two persons, who came on a bullet motorcycle and the complainant identified two persons as Happy and Vasan Singh.

The complainant had filed a divorce case against the present petitioner-Ramanbir Kaur. No role has been attributed to the present petitioner in the FIR. She was facing a trial and was on regular bail and due to her health problem, she could not appear before the Court on 10.07.2013, thereafter, she was declared a proclaimed offender on 21.10.2013. Thereafter, she was arrested on 27.09.2014. In the meantime, vide judgment

dated 14.05.2014, the co-accused Amrik Singh has been convicted.

Counsel for the State on instructions from Head Constable Karam Singh has informed this Court that out of 16 witnesses 14 have since been examined.

Accordingly, keeping in view the above facts, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Amritsar.
