The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No. 360 dated 30.11.2014 under Sections 395, 397, 420, 120-B I.P.C registered at Police Station, Zirakpur, District S.A.S. Nagar Mohali.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR in question was registered on the statement of Punjab Singh on the allegations that he has been cheated for a sum of ₹ 51 Lacs by accused Rana and Harry on the pretext of

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sending his nephew Varinder Singh abroad. Further allegations are also in regard to a swift car having been snatched away.

It would be apposite to notice that on the initial statement of Punjab Singh complainant name of the present petitioner has not been figured. Petitioner has been implicated on the supplementary statement of complainant in which role of present petitioner is stated to be a kingpin and main conspirator.

It has also gone uncontroverted that petitioner was arrested on 13.01.2015 and investigation having been completed and challan has been presented on 13.04.2015.

Allegations are with regard to extorting of ₹ 51 Lacs and snatching of car against co-accused Rana and Harry.

In the totality of circumstances and without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Mohali.

Disposed of.
