Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner is presently living in Australia. Due to his live-in-relationship with a girl belonging to Punjab, his family members are annoyed with him. They called him to India and thrashed him. They have also retained his passport and other documents with them. Now, he is having threat to his life and liberty from his mother, grand-mother, sister and brother-in-law, who are respondents No.4 to 7. It is further submitted that respondent No.5, sister of petitioner is in police and is giving threat to him. Learned counsel for the petitioner has limited his prayer for disposal of this petition with direction to respondent No.2 to dispose of his representation

and to take appropriate action in the matter in accordance with law.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on merits, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran to look into the representation (Annexure P-3) and take appropriate action in accordance with law on receipt of certified copy of this order along with representation (Annexure P-3).
