Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is, inter alia, for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his other family members as she apprehends danger at the hands of accused persons in FIR No.38 dated 12.03.2015, registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Sarhali, Distt. Tarn Taran.

On the last date of hearing, the petitioner along with the prosecutrix, were directed to appear before the Court and service upon them was ordered to be effected through the SSP, Tarn Taran as none caused representation on behalf of the petitioner.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that HC Balbir Singh visited the house of the petitioner and got noted the date for appearance before this Court. The petitioner along with the prosecutrix, took a copy of the notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. but refused to sign it saying that they have been advised by their advocate not to sign any document. They have not come present in the Court either. The learned arguing counsel for the petitioner has also not caused appearance and a date is sought on his behalf.

In these circumstances, this Court feels that the present petition is without any merit and same is hereby dismissed.
