The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take action against the accused as mentioned in the representation annexed with the petition as Annexure P-1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that his grievance will be redressed if the Superintendent of Police, Jagraon, is directed to consider his representation and decide the same.
