This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.446 dated 20.11.2014 under Sections 306/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar, Sonapat.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

Deceased in the present case is Parmod, who is stated to have committed suicide on 20.11.2014 by hanging himself with the help of a plastic rope. FIR was registered on the complaint of Balbir i.e. father of the deceased.

Perusal of the FIR would reveal that Parmod (since deceased) was married to Madhu and with whom he did not have cordial relations. Allegations primarily were targeted against Madhu as regards having lodged false complaints and having harassed her husband Parmod (since deceased). Further allegations were also raised against the mother of Madhu, namely, Meena as also her brother, namely, Vikram (present petitioner).

While issuing notice of motion on 15.01.2015 in the present

petition, petitioner had been directed to join investigation and ad interim protection as regards arrest had been granted.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Bijender has apprised the Court that the petitioner has already joined investigation and furthermore, the investigation process having been completed, challan has been presented on 04.04.2015 and subsequently, on 20.04.2015 even charges have been framed.

Under such circumstances, prayer made in the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is held entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

Petition is allowed. Order dated 15.01.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.
